Materials and equipment for all activities are provided by Kamp Kiwanis.

### LUNCH:

Families are asked to bring their own lunch and any morning/afternoon snacks they might require (hot water, refrigeration and a microwave are not available). We may have some food trucks on site to provide food service but it is best to be prepared in case they are not available. \*We try to keep our site as peanut and nut free as possible so we ask that packed lunches and snacks are PEANUT/NUT-FREE

# **CLOTHING:**

- Hats
- Sweaters
- Rain jackets
- Closed toed shoes (canoeing and forest hikes)
- Extra socks

Many of our activities take place outside so please dress for the weather and bring extra layers when weather permits. Kamp Kiwanis closely follows Bragg Creek Weather patterns so make sure you check the weather for Bragg Creek when packing for the day!

### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- 2 Face Masks per person\*
- Attendees may choose to bring and use their own hand sanitizer (Kamp Kiwanis has several hand sanitizer and hand washing stations)
- Day pack
- Water bottle for each person
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Camera/Phone (Kamp Kiwanis is not responsible for lost or damaged items)
- Any medication that your family might need to take during the day

### **OPTIONAL ITEMS:**

- Baby/Toddler carrier recommended instead of stroller (most of the site is accessible by stroller but some areas such as canoeing/hiking trails will be better accessed with a carrier)
- Money for market area (Cash/Credit/Debit accepted)
